

ORDINANCE # 17-04-01

An ORDINANCE authorizing use of alcohol for invitees at scheduled private events at the Clifton Shelter House and at private events at Clifton Opera House, held in accordance with Opera House License Agreement, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, The State of Ohio has approved the use of alcohol for private parties, under limited and specified conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Clifton desires to expand the approval of the controlled consumption of alcohol to private parties at Village facilities, in order to promote the highest and best economic use of the facilities in the Village.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Clifton:

Section 1: Any use of alcohol in the Opera House or Shelter House by private parties will need prior approval by the Village Council.

Section 2: Alcohol can be consumed only in the Opera House building or in a circumscribed area of the Shelter vicinity. Signs shall be posted indicating "Private Party Only."

Section 3: Consumption of alcohol at such events will be limited to private parties, meaning invited guests, only. A copy of the invitation will be provided to Village Council.

Section 4: Alcohol will be provided and served by private party, without charge to invitees. Invitees may not bring their own alcohol.


Section 5: The private party will be responsible for serving alcohol only to of-age and non-intoxicated guests and will be solely responsible for any and all alcohol consumption consequences.

Section 6: Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare and morals; therefore this Resolution shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and approval, by the Mayor.


